Permits start on January 1st and run through next January 15th of next year . We Do Not Prorate Permits .

PERMITS ARE FOR BAGGED TRASH ONLY,

ANYTHING ELSE WILL BE WEIGHED

(Construction, Remodeling items, Furniture, Extra Bags past your weekly limit, Pallets, Electronics)

If permit is not on window you will have to pay

Limits per week for Permits

Limits: 10 SMALL BAGS (4-15 GALLON) PER WEEK or 5 LARGE BAGS (30-40 GALLON) PER WEEK or 3 EXTRA LARGE BAGS (42-55 GALLON) PER WEEK

IF YOUR LOAD EXCEEDS THE POSTED LIMITS, REGULAR CHARGES WILL APPLY.

Recycling

Almost everything in recycling is free, except for electronics. Electronics are weighed same as trash. Electronics go right to the tipping floor (trash area) outside under the shed.

What recycling items are Free

Cardboard, paper, metal, aluminum cans, tin cans, Led batteries, #1 & #2 plastic only.

ONLY FOR HOUSEholds

Fluorescent Bulbs, Oil, Antifreeze

Items not permitted here:

Cars, Campers, Pesticides, Medical Waste, Flammable Substances, Insecticides, Mercury, Ballasts, PCB's Asbestos, Acids, Radioactive or Toxic Waste.

Wet paint and other liquids must be turned into a solid. Using Kitty litter or Sand and mix till it turns into a solid. Also must be paid by the pound.

Please Separate all recycled Items and put them in the right bins.
